HEART OF AMERICA

Day 1

Today we head to the Heartland of America - the Quad Cities. Located on the Mississippi River, we will be moving between Iowa and Illinois as we visit Rock Island, Moline, East Moline and Davenport. Davenport is home to Deere & Company and our first taste of this area will be the **John Deere Pavilion** on the banks of the Mississippi where we will explore immersive and interactive exhibits. We then check into our hotel for the next three nights - **Stoney Creek** located on the banks of the Mississippi River and in the heart of downtown Moline. Dinner is included tonight at the hotel.

Day 2

After an included breakfast at the hotel, our heartland visit continues with a tour of the **John Deere Factory Headquarters**. We will use a mobile cart for a guided tour of Davenport Works - where 4WD loaders, dump trucks and skidders are manufactured. We then head to **LeClaire, Iowa** for shopping and lunch on our own. Make sure to stop by the original **Antique Archaeology** which was made famous from the show American Pickers. This is your chance to get an up-close look at popular picks from the show like Laurel and Hardy, the buried Indian, Phillip Morris, and more! Customers are able to experience the shop as equal parts, museum, and retail space. Next we peek into the personal life of **Charles Deere** as we tour his home build in 1872. After some time to freshen up at the hotel, we conclude our evening with a ride down the Mississippi on the **Celebration Belle** - the largest non-gaming riverboat on the upper Mississippi. In addition to the amazing views, live entertainment and dinner is included.

Day 3

After an included breakfast, we depart for **Rock Island Arsenal Museum** which opened in 1905. It is the country's second oldest US Army museum only beaten by the famous West Point Museum. Rock Island Arsenal is a major Army installation housing 80 organizations and 6000 military personnel which provide critical products to the Armed Services. From here we head to **Davenport** for shopping and lunch on our own before we arrive at **Chocolate Manor**. We will tour the chocolate factory which, of course, includes samples of chocolate. Our next stop is a tropical paradise tour of the **Botanical Gardens** which includes a 14' waterfall. From there, we will visit **Skeleton Key** - a one-of-a-kind store in a one-of-a-kind historic building. Over 80 vendors lend their expertise and talent to showcase a collection of art, antiques, and locally crafted gifts ideas - all under one roof! Our night concludes with a dinner show featuring the **Jersey Boys**. Jersey Boys takes you behind the music of Frankie Valli and The Four Seasons to discover the secret of a 40-year friendship as the foursome work their way from the streets of New Jersey to the heights of stardom. Audiences will be thrilled with electrifying performances of chart-topping hits

Day 4

After another included breakfast, we begin to work our way home, but our tour is far from over. What heartland tour would be complete without a visit to a dairy farm. Our final destination is at **Fair Oaks Farm**. Lunch will be included at this working farm and we will have the opportunity to learn about Robotic dairy farming, as we tour the farm and see the animals, enjoy a 4D dairy adventure and even visit the birthing room.
