Lancaster, Pennsylvania

Day 1

This morning we depart for Lancaster, PA making rest stops and a lunch stop on our own en route. We will arrive this evening at **Eden Resort** in Lancaster, our home for the next three nights. This evening we will enjoy the Grand Dinner Buffet, located at our hotel.

Day 2

Breakfast is included this morning before departing for a tour through historic **Amish farmlands** in an **authentic Amish buggy**. Our Amish or Mennonite driver will narrate along the way telling about the Amish and Mennonite way of life. We will stop at a working Amish farm while traveling the back roads of Amish country. You will have the opportunity to purchase home made snacks but it is cash only. This afternoon, we visit the beautiful town **Lititz, PA** for some shopping time and lunch on our own. Lititz is a treasure spot in the heart of Lancaster County, boasting a vibrant downtown offering trendy eateries, craft beer and one-of-a-kind coffee and pastry shops. Get your sweet and salty fix by visiting the Wilbur Chocolate Museum and store followed by a trip to the Julius Sturgis Pretzel Bakery. After some time to freshen up at the hotel, we depart for **Bird-In-Hand** to enjoy a delicious dinner. When we were done eating we will finish our evening off by attending the stage production "**Dear Soldier Boy**." What could go wrong when a young Amish girl and her friend volunteer to write letters of encouragement to the American troops stationed in Iraq? It's a pure and noble mission, but it gets a bit complicated (and more than a little comedic) when several of the soldiers out on a weekend pass decide to surprise the girls at the cheese shop where they work - all on the same day!

Day 3

Another breakfast is included this morning before departing for the **Amish Experience**. We will view the film, "**Jacob's Choice**" and tour an authentic **Amish Homestead**. Shopping and lunch is on our own this afternoon at **Kitchen Kettle Village** in Lancaster before departing for the **Sight and Sound Theatre** to see the production of "**Moses**." From the banks of the Nile River to the depths of the Red Sea, **MOSES** is a spectacular entertainment experience for the whole family! Set adrift as a baby, he is an unlikely hero — until God calls him to lead His people out of Egypt and into the Promised Land. Journey with Moses as he ventures through the wilderness, encounters God at the burning bush, and ascends to the top of Mount Sinai. Dinner will be included following the show at the **Miller's Smorgasborg** before returning to our hotel for the remainder of the evening. At Miller's, they cook from scratch and prepare meals that you want to tell your friends about. They get supplies like sweet corn, tomatoes, watermelon, cabbage, broccoli, squash, peppers and onions from Amos, Ben, Manny and Elmer, their Amish neighbors, whose farms surround the restaurant.

Day 4

After a final included breakfast this morning, we depart for home making rest and meal stops en route for our comfort and convenience.
