Day 1

We begin the day meeting our professional Bianco Tour director and driver and then we head north. We'll stop for lunch on our own before arriving at **Cops and Doughnuts**, in Clare, MI, for a unique experience. This doughnut shop and bakery was within weeks of closing when the members of the Clare Police Department came together and purchased the business. Browse the gift shop, purchase a warm fresh donut and even have your mugshot taken! We will then check into **Boyne Mountain Resort** - our home for the night. From the lodge, a short walk takes you to the chair lift where you will ride to the top of the mountain. Stop in at the **Eagle's Nest** at the top of the mountain for a snack and a drink before making your way across the **Skybridge**. At a length of 1,203 feet and soaring 118 feet in the air, it's the world's longest timber-towered suspension bridge with amazing bird's eye views throughout the valley. You may choose to return across the bridge and back down the chairlift or enjoy the paved walking path for the return. Dinner tonight is at the resort.

Day 2

After an included breakfast, we leave to explore **Charlevoix**. Our local guide will lead us through Charlevoix on a tour of the "**Gnome Homes**," designed by the area's famous architect, Earl Young. Earl Young was a dreamer, designer and builder of unique and fascinating stone houses that accommodate each building site with unusual stone fireplaces, chimneys, cedar shake roofs and rooms with flowing curves, also known as "Mushroom Houses." We will have time to explore the quaint downtown shops in Charlevoix and have lunch on our own before arriving at **Lavender Hill Farm**. With more than 29 varieties of lavender on 33 acres, this farm offers a remarkable "hands-on" experience for everyone. Stroll the structured lavender labyrinth, walk the mile long walking trail, visit the sunflower plots, and watch the bees at work. In August lavender is being hand harvested across the entire farm. Stop by the drying shed where thousands of bunches will be hung, bloom side down, on long ropes gently swaying in the summer breeze. The aroma from the still house can be noticed from the parking area and near the end of the month, the blooming sunflowers attract visitors and photographers alike. On the **golf cart tour** we will learn about lavender plants, honeybees, the historic event barn, how they grow and harvest, and the lavender essential oil distillation process. We will also sample Moomers lavender ice cream and lavender lemonade. From there we will head home with fond memories of our beautiful vacation. Thank you for travelling with Bianco Tours!
